Do you ever wonder where to begin stitching on an appliqué block? In this method, you mark on the back and appliqué on the front. Enjoy working together with Margaret as you learn to think through the process step-by-step and layer-by-layer. You'll work from background to foreground as you patiently build and stitch the sweet little Impatiens block using Margaret's Trace, Baste, Snip & Stitch method. The Impatiens block is excerpted from Margaret's newest quilt, Grandmother's Kitchen, evoking the cozy heart and comforting hearth of the family home. This technique makes it a delight to stitch by hand and so, sew simple to get graceful curves as well as crisp inside and outside points. Join the fun and let Margaret show you how!

Supplies:

A material fee is required and includes: Impatiens block pattern piece excerpted from the quilt pattern (required for class), (1) 9" x 9" square of neutral batik – background fabric, (1) 3" x 6" rectangle of red batik – appliqué flower petals, (1) 3" x 3" square of light green batik – appliqué flower stem/calyx, (1) 5" x 5" square of dark green batik – appliqué stem & leaves, (1) No. 7 sharp needle – basting, (1) No.11 Milliner's needle – stitching, (1) spool of 28 wt. thread – basting, **use of** Aurifil 80 wt. thread – stitching appliqué in class (red and greens), 3-page tips for successful hand reverse appliqué handout, 2-page list of helpful blogs and tutorials, instructions to hand appliqué, and (1) eye of the beholder tote bag.

Materials Fee: \$19.50 (payable in class, cash preferred)

Please bring the following items to class:

- Basic Sewing Supplies
- (1) Pair of small, sharp scissors (Margaret recommends the Kai 4" bent-handled sharp-tipped scissors can be used for paper and fused fabric)
- (5-8) Appliqué pins
- (4-5) Straight pins
- Light box trace design onto wrong side of background batik
- Mechanical pencil **OR** Frixion gel pen tracing pattern onto wrong side of background batik

Optional: Needle threader – small-eyed needle and beam n' read personal light.

An optional fabric kit is available and includes: Grandmother's Kitchen Quilt pattern with ½" sasher, 3 yd. of blue print fabric, 3 yd. of neutral fabric, 1¼ yd. of blue print fabric 2, 1 yd. of dark red fabric, ½ yd. of light blue fabric, ½ yd. of light green fabric, ½ yd. of light red fabric, Fat quarter/ ¼ yd. each of dark green and black fabric, and a Fat eighth/ ⅓ yd. each of 3 yellow fabrics. \$197.50

An optional hand accessory kit is available and includes: (1) pair of Kai bent-handled, slightly blunt-tipped scissors, (1) spool of hand basting thread, (1) pack of No. 7 sharps needles, and (1) pack of No. 11 milliner's needles. **\$24.38**
