Join the fun and be empowered! Make the elegantly playful Tudor Rose Mug Rug by hand reverse appliqué for a unique, dimensional look! The techniques you will use are the same for both appliqué and reverse appliqué. It's just a matter of knowing where to cut to create your seam allowance. You will learn Margaret's quick and easy steps in Eye of the Beholder's trace, baste, snip, and stitch process to create your mug rug by hand. Margaret will give you pointers on how to successfully needle-turn appliqué, giving you crisp points and graceful curves. See the dimensional magic of the Tudor Rose Mug Rug (8" x 8") revealed as you stitch. It's so cute in an assortment of colors, you can't make just one. What color will you make yours in? Learn with others and experience the fun and beauty of reverse appliqué by hand!

### **Supplies:**

A material fee is required and includes: Beehive & Tudor Rose Mug Rug pattern, tips to successfully hand reverse appliqué hand out, list of tutorials and blogs, (1) No. 7 Sharps needle, (1) No. 11 Milliner's needle, and (1) spool of light colored basting thread, eye of the beholder tote bag.

**Materials Fee: \$20** (payable in class, cash preferred)

*Please bring the following items to class:*

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- (1) 8½" x 8½" square of dark batik – top fabric
- (1) 8½" x 8½" square of light batik – background fabric
- (1) 8" x 8" square of accent batik – appliqué flower parts
- (1) spool each of 60 **OR** 80 wt. threads – hand stitching (same colors as top and appliqué fabrics)
- (5) safety pins **OR** straight pins – pin basting
- Mechanical pencil **OR** Frixion gel pen – tracing pattern onto wrong side of background fabric
- (1) Pair of small, sharp scissors (Margaret recommends the Kai 4" bent-handled blunt-tipped scissors - can be used for paper and fused fabric)
- Desk needle threader
- Light box

- The following items will be needed to finish your Mug Rug (finishing will not be part of the scope of the class):
  - (1) 9" x 9" square of dark backing fabric (suggest same as top fabric)
  - (1) 2" x 36" dark or accent binding strip (you may also want to finish as a pot holder)

**Optional:** Beam N' Read personal light

**An optional kit is available and includes:** Assorted colorways (each kit makes 4 mug rugs), (2) fat quarters (18" x 22") of top fabric and backing, (1) fat quarter (18" x 22") of background fabric, (1) 1/8 yd. binding, (2) 1/8 yd. of hive under-color fabric appliqué bits and binding, and (2) 1/8 yd. of leaves under-color fabric, appliqué bits and binding. **\$25.00 + shipping** To preorder, go to Margaret's website at [www.eobquilt.com](http://www.eobquilt.com) by March 22, 2024.

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
