Want to make a wallhanging or art quilt pop? Embellish your quilt with 3-D petals and leaves. In this class, you will use floral wire to make 3-D elements creating a very exciting flower. Class Project size is approx. 12x12

Supplies:

Please bring the following items to class:

- [Basic Sewing Supplies](#)
- 24-gauge Floral wire and appropriate scissors for cutting wire
- Tools to assist turning fabric petals in-side out
- Fabric glue
- Approx. (12½" x 12½") solid piece **OR** coordinating fabrics – background (approx. 12½" x 12½")
- 14" x 14" Batting piece
- 14" x 14" Backing fabric
- Binding fabric
- Scrap fabric approx. 5" x 5" – center flower fabric
- All the same **OR** coordinating fabrics/scrap in flower (color of your choice) – flower petal fabric (Note: petals are 2-sided. You will need fabric for both sides of the petal. Approx. (2) Fat quarters (18" x 22"))
- Same **OR** coordinating fabrics/scrap in leaf colors – stem (and leaves optional) fabric (Approx. (1) fat quarter (18" x 22") is enough for (1) stem and an optional (2-3) leaves)
- Wonder Under fusible web - enough for under your stem and flower center (optional but very helpful for leaves and some petals)
- Quilting thread – petals, leaves/stems, and background (match **OR** contrasting for each)
- Simple Flower appliqué pattern. Enlarge so petals are at least 2" x 4" (several will be provided in class)

Optional: Beads **OR** sequins to embellish flower center; additional batting to create trapunto effect on flower center
