Please bring the following items to class:

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- Inspirational photos of a landscape, still life, architecture, flowers, etc.
- Fabrics that will go with your still life inspirations: mix solids, tone-on-tone, and prints with a full value range from very light to very dark fabrics
- 7 values of each color minimum, Katie will show you how to sort into the 7 value steps so several of each value is recommended.
- These colors can be the same as the photo or you can use unexpected colors which adds to the abstractness.
- (4) **OR** more 12½" squares in assorted values – backgrounds unfused
- Glue stick
- Fusible on all fabric choices except for background fabrics

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
