This is a playful, creative workshop. Remember folding and cutting paper snowflakes as a child? You will use similar techniques to explore the design possibilities as you create a mini reverse appliqué medallion pattern. Next, you'll transfer your design onto fusible and put it onto fabric so you can bring it to life, in living color, by machine reverse appliqué using our signature Trace, Snip, Iron & Stich method. Margaret will talk about design considerations along this creative journey.

Supplies:

A material fee is required and includes: **Use of** Terial Magic spray-on stabilizer, handouts, 2-page "design considerations", 2-page list of helpful tutorials and blogs, 1-page "how-to machine reverse appliqué", 3-page "tips to successfully machine reverse appliqué with a satin stitch", and an eye of the beholder tote bag.

Materials Fee: \$8.50 (payable in class, cash preferred)

Please bring the following items to class:

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- Batik fabric (bring a couple combinations of fabric with high value and color contrast that go well together) You will use:
 - (2) 12½" x 12½" squares of fabric - (1) medium-dark and (1) light
- (10) Sheets of 11" x 11" paper (start with 11" x 17" paper and square off to 11" x 11")
- (2) 11" x 11" sheets of dark, sturdy colored paper (construction, file folders)
- Scotch® tape
- 40 wt. **OR** 50 wt. thread **OR** machine embroidery thread – machine satin stitching (same accent/color as the top fabrics)
- (1) Pair of small, sharp scissors (Margaret recommends the Kai 4" bent-handled sharp-tipped scissors - can be used for paper and fused fabric)
- (2) 12½" x 12½" square flexi fuse or other lightweight paper-backed, iron-on fusible
- (5-9) Pins for pin basting (safety and straight)
- Permanent markers: fine tip and wide tip could be helpful
- Lightbox may be helpful for tracing and designing
