Supplies:

A material fee is required and includes: The pattern, foundation papers, handouts, and (1) Square up Ruler.

Materials Fee: \$20 (payable in class, cash preferred)

Please bring the following items to class:

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- Choose a variety of print **OR** solid fabrics
- Background fabric (this can also be a variety of fabrics)

You will need the following:

- (2) prints and (2) backgrounds:
 - (2) 4" squares (4 squares total)
 - (2) 5¾" squares (4 squares total)
 - (4) 8" squares (8 squares total)
 - (1) 4" x WOF (width of fabric) strip (2 strips total) – Note: These can be cut from fat quarters: (18" x 22"), but you will need double the strips.
 - (3) 3" x WOF (width of fabric) strips (6 strips total) – Note: These can be cut from fat quarters: (18" x 22"), but you will need double the strips.
 - (1) 3½" x WOF (width of fabric) strips (2 strips total) – Note: These can be cut from fat quarters: (18" x 22"), but you will need double the strips.
- (2) fat quarters (18" x 22") of each print and background – creative play

Note: Look for good contrast between your prints and background fabrics

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
