- Westalee Design Spacing Gauge. Available at <https://www.sewsteady.com/> or at your local quilt shop
- Westalee Design **low shank** 12" Arc Template. Available at <https://www.sewsteady.com/> or at your local quilt shop
- Cut (8) 8½" x 8½" pieces of solid, medium to dark cotton fabric. With a thin permanent marker, (an ink pen will work), mark each fabric with a 6-inch square that has a 1/4-inch outer border. NOTE: for best results mark fabric before making the quilt sandwich. *The inner square MUST be 6 inches.
- Cut (8) 10½" x 10½" pieces of low/medium loft cotton batting
- Cut (8) 10½" x 10½" pieces of muslin – backing (mark with a thin permanent marker **OR** an ink pen)
- Marking ruler at least 12½" x 3½"
- Fine marking pen OR pencil
