### **Supplies:**

Please bring the following items to class:

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- Around 3 to 4 yd. total of different fabrics: Choose any that you love! Consider using fabrics that are highly patterned and colored, specialty fabrics, one-of-a-kind printed fabrics, dyed fabrics, digitally-printed fabrics, etc. (Include several options for a good color story with a minimum size 12" x 12") Kevin will discuss your options in class.
- (1) Color photo approximately 8½" x 11" size. It does not have to be those exact dimensions, just anywhere close. This needs to not be precious to you as we will be cutting it up. A photo from an old calendar or a colorful photo from a magazine are good examples. Any image will work as long as it is colorful.
- (1) glue stick
- A couple of pieces of plain paper
- Rulers: A ruler that is 6" **OR** 6½" square is ideal. Any size square from 3½" up to 12" will work.
- (1) (50" x 70") piece of flannel **OR** batting to act as your design board
- (1) roll of blue painters tape
- Straight pins – pinning your design
- A camera -- this can be on your mobile phone.
