- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- (1) yd. of background fabric A – star feathers and setting pieces
- (5/8) yd. of fabric B – star feathers
- (1) strip (1 1/2" x WOF (width of fabric)) of fabric C – star points
- (3/8) yd. of fabric D – star block center
- 6" **OR** smaller square ruler with a 45-degree diagonal line
- Corner Trimmer (#8064) by Marti Michell
- Plastic baggies to carry precut pieces
