- 1 yd. of background fabric A – star feathers and setting pieces
- $\frac{5}{8}$ yd. of fabric B – star feathers
- $1\frac{1}{8}$ yd. of fabric C – star points, outer border, and binding
- $\frac{3}{8}$ yd. of fabric D – star block center and border blocks
- 6" **OR** smaller square ruler with 45-degree diagonal line
- Plastic baggies to carry precut pieces
- Corner Trimmer (#8064) by Marti Michell (\$5, available to purchase in class) **OR** Triangle Trimmer by Fons & Porter
