She'll discuss both innovative and traditional cutting/design techniques and she'll show you how to do her amazing NEW technique of putting the mosaic design together without the need for a light box or fabric marking tools. Once you've built your design, you'll layer the quilt, do some simple free-motion quilting and finish it off with a pretty binding and just a touch of fairy dust glitter.
