Supplies:

Please bring the following items to class:

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- Strips and scraps of cotton fabric. (solids, batiks, tone on tone, small scale prints, **OR** a combination) Avoid large scale prints. **OR** if you don't have strips and scraps handy, (6-8) fat quarters (18" x 22") should provide a good variety.
- ½ yd. of neutral fabric **OR** several fat quarters (18" x 22") in several different tones **OR** shades of the same color - background
- 9½" square ruler
