Supplies:

A kit is required and includes: A two-piece acrylic ruler.

Kit Fee: \$10 (payable in class, cash preferred)

Please bring the following items to class:

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- Approx. 1 yd. of fabric – Large outer hexie (Enough for (23-25) hexies). You can cut strips 6" wide **OR** use 6"x7" pieces - both the front and the back of the Quilt.
- Batting – strips 5" wide **OR** approx. 5" squares from scraps (Enough for (23-25) hexies) **OR** fusible batting.
- Approx. $\frac{3}{4}$ yd. of fabric – Inner hexie (Enough for (23-25) hexies). You can cut strips 5" wide **OR** use 5" squares from scraps to coordinate with the Large Outer Hexie Fabric. You can also fussy cut fabric **OR** use 5" pieced fabric/blocks. (Charm packs work great.)
- Thread to match large outer fabric (Can also use contrasting **OR** invisible thread)
- Thread to quilt the inner fabric (can match **OR** contrast)
