Think of this technique as two-step quilting. This class yields perfect quilted blocks embellished with a variety of appliqué options, then assembled. Quilting through each block and batting individually makes quilting easy for both new and experienced quilters alike – no bulk or awkward struggling with a large sandwiched quilt. A great project for increasing accuracy, as well as small space quilting, like retreats! Add backing fabric and the second step quilting and you are done. Make any size quilt and appliqué in endless options.

Supplies:

Please bring the following items to class:

- [Basic Sewing Supplies](#)
- (25) 5" squares of coordinated fabric – quilt top. Fabric can be fussy cut **OR** pieced. (5" Charm packs work great)
- Assorted accent fabric scraps, approx. fat quarter's (18" x 22") worth to contrast with your background
- ¾ yd. any color of backing fabric
- ¼ yd. of binding fabric (will be needed to complete project at home)
- ¼ yd. of Wonder Under fusible web
- (25) 4" squares of 2-sided fusible batting
- Parchment paper **OR** Teflon pressing sheet
- Scissors
- Straight pins
- Ruler – 5" square **OR** larger – squaring up rows
- Oblong 4"x14" ruler **OR** bigger – squaring up rows
- Thread – piecing, quilting, and zigzag to contrast **OR** match your background and accent fabric
