- (5-7) basted practice quilt sandwiches (top, batting, backing fabric) at least 12" square (solids preferred)
- (1) 22" square piece of batting
- (1) 24" square fabric of your choice (this is for the backing on the panel)
- Notebook, Pen, and Pencil
- Thread to match fabrics
- Thread to contrast fabrics
- Neutral-colored thread
- Quilting gloves
- Basting pins
- 40-50wt Thread

Optional: (8.5" x 11") (ish) dry erase **OR** LED writing board
