In class, you will learn how to make these cool and eye catching elements and create two blocks; once you've mastered the technique, you'll want to add them to all sorts of projects!

Supplies:

Please bring the following items to class:

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- ¼ yd. of background fabric (fat **OR** regular) (included in optional kit)
- (8) scraps of color one (8 different fabrics) (included in optional kit)
- (8) scraps of color two (8 different fabrics) (included in optional kit)
- ⅛ yd. accent (WOF best) (included in optional kit)
- Thread – piecing
- (1) small safety pin
- Trimmer **OR** ruler – trimming half square triangles
- If you own the Clearly Perfect Slotted Trimmers bring them (will also be available in class, \$32).
OR a small square ruler for trimming.

Optional:

An optional kit is available and includes: ¼ yd. of background fabric, (8) scraps of color one, and (8) scraps of color two. **\$10**
