Let these adorable little burrowing owls teach you how easy appliqué can be. Each bird is created as a unit off block. Apliquick tools are required for this workshop. This finished edge technique is the fastest, most precise, and easiest appliqué technique that Kathy has discovered in 20 years of making applique quilts. You will be amazed at its swift learning curve. After turning your edges, you can hand or machine applique your owls together and to the background. Enhance the visual impact of your little owls by adding details with embroidery stitches. Students are so excited with this method that has been sweeping the appliqué world. This Block is from Kathy's famous Audubon Christmas Quilt.

Supplies:

A pattern/fabric kit is required and includes: \$13.95 Pattern. Your Fabric kit includes all 14 fabrics for your three owls. One owl has all the Apliquick templates already cut out and ironed to the fabric, so you can save time and get right to turning your edges in class. No background fabric is needed in class. Kathy will discuss how to create your own background scene.

- Appliqué pins
- Needles
- 4" scissors (available from instructor in class)
- Silk thread (available from instructor in class)
- Turning rods
- (1) unit of Apliquick interfacing
- (1) glue pen
- Apliquick tools are required for this class (bring your own or order Kathy's Basic Apliquick tool set from her website for **\$58**. This included (2) stainless steel turning rods, (1) unit of Apliquick interfacing for your template material, (1) glue pen, and (1) glue refill.)
