Machine embroidery adds personality to your quilts and needlework. The stitches you choose affect the emotion and atmosphere of your work. In this workshop, you will make a simple sampler using a repeated leaf appliqué, but by changing the finishing embroidery stitches, each leaf takes on different personalities and attitudes. Sample some stitches you have never tried before and try to find the stitches which speak to you to make your needle projects more expressive. - Small, sharp embroidery scissors
- Seam ripper
- Basic 50 wt. sewing threads to contrast with leaf and stem fabrics

For precutting instructions, [click here](#). Precutting must be done before class, as there will not be class time available for cutting. Leaves should be fused to background before class.

*Supplies needed for precutting (at home before class):*

- 19" X 24" fabric - background
- ½ yd. cotton fabric - any color of solid or simple print for leaves
- (1) fat quarter (18" x 22") - stems
- (1) yd. Pellon® ShirTailor® iron-on interfacing
- (1) yd. Wonder-Under or other paper-backed fusible web
