- Required Shaded Four Patch technique sheet (available for purchase in class for \$7.50)

16 units will be made in class using the following fabric: (56 units total required to finish project)

- (4) narrow strips cut to (2 ¾" X 12") - for small squares in various bright colored fabric
- (8) rectangles cut to (5" X 6") - for large triangles in various bright colored fabric
- (4) wide strips cut to (3¾" X 12") - in white background fabric
- Tucker Trimmer® I Tool is required (if you do not have this item, you may purchase this from the teacher for \$24.50)
- Neutral colored thread
- 6" X 12" General purpose cutting ruler
- Fine line marker
