This skill-builder class is focused on the most versatile building block in a quilter's bag of tricks: the half-square triangle. Explore 10 different ways to make half-square triangles, learn the math behind it, and play with a collection of tools to help make them more quickly and accurately. Includes foundation piecing, template use, accurate $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams, triangle quilt math plus formulas for up and down-sizing to fit your designs.

Supplies:

A material fee is required and includes: Pattern, foundation papers, handouts, and Square Up Ruler.

Materials Fee: \$20 (payable in class, cash preferred)

Please bring the following items to class:

- Choose a variety of prints (or solids will work well too) and a background fabric (you can work from yardage or scraps). Look for good contrast between your prints and background fabrics. From both a print (or solid) fabric and a background fabric, you'll need the following:
- (2) 4" squares, (4) squares total: 2 prints and 2 backgrounds
- (2) 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ " squares, (4) squares total
- (4) 8" squares, (8) squares total
- (1) 4" X WOF strips, (2) strips total (these can be cut from fat quarters: 4" x 21")
- (3) 3" X WOF strips, (6) strips total (these can be cut from fat quarters: 3" x 21")
- (1) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " X WOF strips, (2) strips total (these can be cut from fat quarters: 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 21")
- (2) fat quarters each print and background - creative play
- Fabric marker (both light and dark)
- Paper scissors
- Seam ripper
- Straight pins
- Thread to match fabrics
