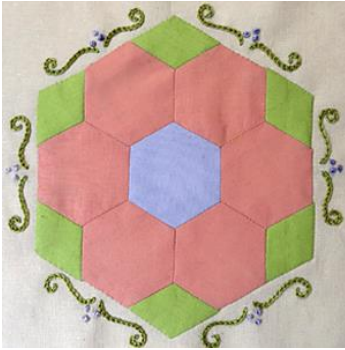

The oldest recorded English paper pieced quilt in the British Isles dates to 1718. Times have changed but handwork is ageless, and slow stitching is here to stay. Catherine has been an English paper piecer since her teens in the 1970s and has won national awards for her hand stitched quilts. Join her to learn her tested traditional techniques for beautiful accurate piecing. You'll start with hexagons to work on the basics, then try diamonds, triangles and partial shapes. Learn about fussy cutting and free form piecing. Finish class ready to work on your own design, as modern and up to date as you desire!
