Students will use a walking foot and 12, 28, 40, and 50-weight threads to create a mini quilt that will work as a wallhanging or pillow top. Learn to efficiently and effectively do matchstick quilting, use thread color to activate the negative space of a quilt, and experience how thread weight can be used to alter the effect of quilting stitches on your project. A kit is required and includes: printed fabric panel, backing, batting, (1) small spool white 50wt thread, large spool 12wt thread in color 1, small spool 40wt thread in color 1, small spool 28wt thread in color 2, small spool 50wt thread in color 2, size 14 topstitch needle for domestic machine, safety pins for basting, and color printed handout.
