This eye-catching and vibrant block has the appearance of stained glass...a result of combining folded cutwork with reverse appliqué. Although best for a confident beginner to intermediate level, a student brand new to appliqué could do this block because the design allows the easiest sections to be done first. Students will learn the folded cutwork technique...a process of folding freezer paper and cutting out a design (just like the snowflakes we cut out as kids). - Clover White marker
- Exacto Knife
- 10" – 12" small cutting mat (optional)
- Mechanical Pencil
- Paper Scissors
