This block is designed for first-timers! You will learn to both needle-turn appliqué and to the folded cutwork technique. The block finishes at approximately 12" x 12". As the name implies, the process of needle-turn appliqué uses the point of the needle to turn under raw edges of the fabric. The pattern is created by folding freezer paper and cutting out a design...just like making snowflakes. In this class, students will learn the four basic elements of needle turn: the inside and outside of both curves and points. Audra has some tried and true tips and tricks that make points and curves easier, taking the fear out of the dreaded "A" word.

- Needles (sharps and appliqué)
- Basting thread
- Small pair of sharp scissors for clipping and trimming
- Paper Scissors
- Pins
- Erasable marker (light or dark, depending on color choice of your batik fabric)
