Elevate a traditional Baltimore-style wreath by adding your first or last initial to the block. Rosebuds, cherries, assorted flowers, and leaves create this unique block. The classic outer wreath is standard scale, while the initial motif is slightly smaller. All letter patterns from A - Z will be available for students' use. You will learn everything about Annie's technique for successful machine appliqué. It's easily attainable - you'll love it. The finished size of this project is (18" x 18"). Supplies:

A kit is required and includes: Pattern for project, choice of initial pattern, fusible web, pencil, self-threading needle, additional notions, and starch

Kit Fee: \$25 (payable in class, cash preferred)

Please bring the following items to class:

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**

Most of the appliqué will take scraps of fabric, not yardage. Fat eighths are perfect and you'll have some left. This is how the fabric selections break down:

- (4) shades of Magenta for the roses, Annie used light to dark (the lightest being pink)
- Dark Green for the large stem that makes the wreath - (1) fat quarter (18" x 22") need for this fabric.
- Green for all of the leaves and rosebuds.
- (2) Blues for the bird
- (1) Yellow for the dots
- (3) selections of Orange - light to dark
- (7) Purples - light to dark

*You don't have to use the color selections that Annie did -- just remember to use a gradation of color when choosing your fabrics.

- One Fat quarter **OR** half yard of background fabric
- Small pair of precision scissors (Annie likes the Elan E6 scissors and will have them for sale in class (\$18)
- The Ultimate Applique Resource Tool (C&T Publishing) - you can get it online, or let me know and I will bring them for sale (\$19.95)

September 11-14, 2024

- You will need thread to match each of your appliqué fabrics. Annie uses Aurifil 28 weight thread, which is a little thicker than 50 weight and has a beautiful sheen. She will have an assortment of those threads for sale in class. Sometimes one thread will work for two or more fabrics. An optional kit is available and includes: **NOTE*** There are two optional kits - Fabric kit **\$48**: Background fabric, a variety of Cherrywood hand-dyed fabrics for the appliqué details, SF101 stabilizer.
