Note: Examples of color combinations for Hue A & B can be analogous colors, complementary colors, or any color and a neutral color. Prepare all your fabrics by ironing with your preferred fabric starch.

- 18" x 22" piece of freezer paper
- Notebook and pencil for taking notes
- Fabric marker (water erasable or chalk)
- Pins
- Paper scissors
