Throughout the class, she will demonstrate how to make an optional miniature version using the scraps and cutaways from the main project. Students will create one block and be prepared for completion of the entire piece. Once the New York Beauty blocks are created, you'll add some strips, skew the blocks, and you have created a fabulously dynamic quilt top!

A kit is required and includes: Full color handout to complete the quilt, foundation paper that stays in the quilt, custom acrylic templates and a re-useable foundation piecing stencil.

- (4) 8" squares solid black
- (24) 3" x 4" rectangles black and white dots
- (4) 4½" squares of hot pink
- (20) 2-1/2" x 3½" rectangles orange
- (4) 2½" x 8½" strip of lime green
- (1) 2½" x 8½" strip of orange
- (12) 2½" x 8½" strips of black and white dots
- Small square ruler – 8½ OR 9½
- Tracing/vellum paper OR template plastic
- Permanent marker – Black
- Pigma® Brush Tip Pen (available in class for purchase \$4)
