- (1) fat quarter (18" x 22") - background fabric (solid or prints)
- (4) 10" squares - fabric, variety of colors (these squares will be your organic shapes, can be solids or prints)
- Fine-tip Fabric Scissors
- Washable glue with a **fine point** applicator (could be a Helmer's glue or Roxane glue for basting) (this material is KEY to achieve a good result)
- Fabric marker (erasable)
