- 1 yd. assortment – medium-to-dark fabric (or use leftover precut strips that are at least ½" X 32" to 3" X 32" and anywhere in between with the width)
- Creative Grid CGRT12560 (12½") 60° Triangle template **OR** CGR60DIA designed by Krista Moser
- Strip cutting rulers with 60° registration line (6½" X 24½" **OR** 8½" X 24½")
- Your favorite spray starch
- Fabric marking pen
