Students will create these fun blocks, with only one matching point, in both "planned" scrappy – four fabrics per block, and "completely" scrappy – sixteen fabrics per block which really brings out the possibilities with this design.

- (2) yd. – assorted scraps in one color family or two coordinating color families: Use as many scrap fabrics as you can, cut fabrics for a total:
 - (16) 2½" x 6½" rectangles
 - (16) 2½" x 3" rectangles
 - (16) 1½" x 4½" rectangles
 - (16) 1¾" x 4½" rectangles
 - 1½ yd. - background fabric, not cut
