Students will learn how they can change a block’s style by simply adding or subtracting a color, or perhaps rotating a piece here or there. No one’s quilt will look the same. After learning the technique to make the basic Country Crown block, students will begin playing with the fabrics and colors to rock their own blocks!

A kit is required and includes: color handout, reusable foundation piecing stencil, and foundation paper.

Please bring the following items to class:

- 9½" square ruler – Omnigrid or Creative Grids recommended
- 16" square – muslin or batting
- 2½ yd. of cream fabric – background (can be one fabric or use a variety of creams)
- (9) different colors cut from long quarter yard pieces (you can use 5" strips, your scraps, **OR** purchase some long quarter pieces)
- Permanent marker – Black, Fine Point
- Pigma® Brush Tip Pen (available in class for purchase \$4)
- Favorite marking tool – Linda uses Chaco-Liner (\$10, available for purchase in class)
